## 2 Ways to Apply for SNAP

### Online

- Fill out an online application at [www.dcfsl.a.gov/cafe](http://www.dcfsl.a.gov/cafe)
- Gather documents needed to verify the information in your application (ID, SS#, income, expenses)
- Be ready for a phone interview with DCFS. (Make sure you've provided a valid phone number to us!)

### By Mail/Fax

- Fill out a paper application (Get one at [www.dcfsl.a.gov/getsnap](http://www.dcfsl.a.gov/getsnap), or by emailing [LAHelpU.DCFS@la.gov](mailto:LAHelpU.DCFS@la.gov), or by calling 1-888-524-3578)
- Gather documents needed to verify the information in your application (ID, SS#, income, expenses)
- Mail to DCFS Economic Stability, P.O. Box 260031, Baton Rouge, LA 70826 -OR- Fax to 225-663-3164
- Be ready for a phone interview with DCFS. (Make sure you've provided a valid phone number to us!)
