### DCFS Economic Impact

DCFS employs about **3,463** full-time staff around the state. In FFY 2020, **4,310** retailers accepted SNAP benefits, which put **\$1.68 billion** directly into Louisiana's economy, produced about **\$2.59 billion** of total state GDP, and supported approximately **22,827** jobs.

## Sheltering

At the peak of the disaster response, on Sept. 12, there were **18,213 hurricane evacuees** in **78 shelters** in Louisiana and Texas. Of those, 12,990 were in Louisiana. DCFS also supported **3 Isolation Sites** and **1 Medical Monitoring Station** in response to the coronavirus pandemic. Isolation sites were still active as of Dec. 31, and Medical Monitoring Station was placed on standby status in case needed at a later date.

### Food Assistance

Provided more than **\$686.9 million in emergency food assistance**, implemented the nation's first large-scale **fully virtual DSNAP application process** and received **168,091 phone calls** applying for DSNAP benefits in the 3 major hurricanes

- \$137.1M in Pandemic EBT benefits to 284,259 families of school children due to coronavirus-related school closures (In partnership with Louisiana Department of Education)
- \$51.86 million in DSNAP benefits following 3 major hurricanes
  - ▶ \$38M to 56,338 households for Hurricane Laura
  - ▶ \$4.18M to 10,832 households for Hurricane Delta
  - \$9.6M to 26,803 households for Hurricane Zeta
- \$51.6 million in Replacement SNAP benefits for food lost due to power outages of 24+ hours
  - ▶ \$26.78M to 101,768 households for Hurricane Laura
  - ▶ \$15.2M to 122,556 households for Hurricane Delta
  - ▶ \$9.6M to 101,768 households for Hurricane Zeta
- \$446.4 million in Supplemental SNAP benefits (through Dec. 2020 and counting) to bring families up to the maximum monthly allotment by household size due to the coronavirus

#### Responded to an unprecedented food need, with almost 1 million Louisianans now on SNAP

- Received 5 times the normal volume of SNAP applications in the first 30 days of the pandemic
- Served a record 477,227 households (981,751 individuals) in January 2021
- Added 109,000+ SNAP households Up 23% between Jan. 2020 and Jan. 2021
- Monthly SNAP payments more than doubled to \$206.3M Up 112.7% between Jan. 2020 and Jan. 2021

#### Customer Service & Public Information

- Monthly calls to LAHelpU Customer Service Center more than doubled to 175,000+ in April, June and September following the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, P-EBT, and Hurricanes Laura and Delta, respectively.
- Emails for assistance to LAHelpU customer service staff more than tripled last year, from 48,862 in 2019 to 152,275 in 2020.
- DCFS website users increased 300% in March-Dec. 2020, compared to the same period in 2019 from 3.8M in 2019 to 15.2M in 2020. Most of the increase related to SNAP, DSNAP and P-EBT.
